PUPPY: For dogs of 6 months but not exceeding 18 months on the day of the test.

NOVICE DOG/NOVICE HANDLER: For dogs of any age. ND/NH comprises similar tests to those in Puppy. It is aimed at those who are completely new to working tests, and would like to have a go. Neither dog nor handler can have gained any gundog working test place or field trial award, or have won a Novice Dog/Novice Handler.

BEGINNER: For dogs not having won two or more CBRC Beginner tests, or won any Novice gundog working test, or any award in the CBRC Unclassified Open test or any Open working test, or any Field Trial award.

UNCLASSIFIED OPEN: Open to all.

Dogs who run 'Not for Competition' cannot compete in any classes.

Entries

- Closing date for entries: **18 September 2022**. The closing date for entries will be final. Any entries received after the closing date will NOT be accepted under any circumstances.
- If your dog is owned in partnership, ALL owners need to be members of the CBRC.
- Entries £10.00 per class for each dog.
