

Puppy Dog (2, 1)

1ST Glaneils Enjoy The Silence (Mr D N Rigby). Well balanced all through presenting good outline when stacked. Good breadth of skull with small high set ears. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder. Well ribbed back. Scores in hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of very good texture. Moved well once he settled into his stride.

Junior Dog (1)

1ST Tideflight Warrior of Kent (Mr P H Milner). Promising dog with a good outline displaying real strength however his owner really needs to get him under control as it made him very hard to assess. Broad head and strong jaw. Well laid shoulder. Good width and depth of chest and well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Coat a bit wayward but oiliness is present. On the move he presented his handler with the greatest challenge – there is no doubt he can move well but he needs reigning in and come ringcraft in order to demonstrate it.

Yearling Dog (2)

1ST Battsrock Smoke On The Water (Mrs D & Mr T Herring). Good overall balance. Masculine head with good breadth of skull and well set ears. Strong neck. Well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Well ribbed back. I would prefer a little more bend in stifle. Good bone and feet. Rear movement could be tidier but good forward reach. Coat of good texture.

2ND Tideflight Warrior of Kent (Mr P H Milner) – 1st JD

Post Graduate Dog (1)

1ST Great River Ticino of Eastering (Imp Ita) (Mrs F C J Acheson). Well balanced all through and strongly built without being coarse. Balanced head with broad skull and muzzle of equal length. Well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Chest of good depth and well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and good definition of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved out soundly on a good stride.

Limit Dog (1)

1ST Gingerfox Curlew at Muireatai (Miss L Murray). Good overall balance. Masculine head with broad skull and small well set ears. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder. Could have a little more length in upper arm. Chest is of good width and depth. Well sprung ribcage carried well back. Scores in hindquarters with well turned stifles and good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of very good oily texture. Moved on a good length of stride.

Open Dog (4, 1)

1ST Glaneils Count On Me (Mr S A & Mrs C L Broomfield). Impressive dog who is balanced all through. Excellent head with good breadth of skull, slight stop and muzzle of equal length. Strong neck leading to good lay of shoulder and equal length of upper arm. Good depth and breadth of chest. Well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with enough turn of stifle and well placed hocks. Excellent bone and the best of feet. Coat of very good texture. Moved out well on a good length of stride. Shown and handled to advantage. DCC which I understand gives him his title and Best Opposite Sex in Show.

2ND Sh Ch/nld Ch Pixiesrock Mr Tumnus by Bleyos JW (Mr G & Mrs T Boyles). Good overall balance. Lovely head with broad skull and well set ears. Strong neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Strong hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good oily texture. Moved out well – not quite the drive of the winner. RDCC

3RD Riptide Gentlemens Relish (Mr R & Mrs S Playle & Thomas)

Veteran Dog (2, 1)

1ST Sh Ch Chesepe Waco (Mr D N Rigby). Strongly made with good overall balance. Masculine head with broad skull and muzzle of equal length. Reasonable layback of shoulder. Could have a little more angulation of upper arm. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Strong hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved out well on a good stride.

Special Working Dog (2, 1)

1ST Riptide Gentlemens Relish (Mr R & Mrs S Playle & Thomas). Good overall balance. Head has good breadth of skull and muzzle of equal length. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulders. Good length and spring of rib. Scores in hindquarters with well turned stifles of and good definition of second thigh. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved on a good stride.

Puppy Bitch (1)

1ST Glaneils Echo Beach (Mr S A & Mrs C L Broomfield) Very impressive puppy. Litter sister to the dog puppy and very alike. Very well balanced all through presenting very good outline. Feminine head of correct breadth for age with muzzle of equal length. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulder and equal length of upper arm. Correct depth of chest with ribs carried well back. Scores in hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and well placed hocks. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of super oily texture. Moved out with confidence – really enjoying her time in the ring. BPIS.

Yearling Bitch (2)

1ST Bb's Chesapeake Breeding Dory for Arnac (Imp Che) (Mrs C S & Mrs G Mayhew & McCartney) I thought this bitch was absolutely stunning. Beautifully balance she just can't stand wrong. Strongly built but feminine all through. She has the most lovely head with such a soft expression. Slight stop and clean strong jaw. Her neck flows seamlessly into her well laid shoulders with corresponding length and return of upper arm. Good width and depth of chest. Ribcage that is well sprung and carried well back. Strong, muscular hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and good width of second thigh. Well placed hocks. Quality bone and the best of feet. Coat of superb oily texture. Moved out well on a good stride at one with her handler. I had no hesitation in awarding her the BCC and ultimately BIS.

2ND Battsrock Ashes to Ashes for Sharbae (Mrs S Baxandall). Lighter in build but very well balanced. Good head shape with broad skull and high set ears. Well laid shoulder with corresponding return of upper arm. Enough depth of chest. Could have a little more depth in back ribs. Well made hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Good bone and feet. Coat of correct texture. Moved soundly.

Post Graduate Bitch (3)

1ST Oakmarsh Kingsley Adsila (Miss A & Mr S Corcoran & Jones). Very well made bitch who is workmanlike and well balanced all through. Well shaped head with good breadth of skull and well placed ears. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulders. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters which are strong with nicely bent stifles and well placed hocks. Excellent bone and feet. Coat of good texture. Moved well on an even stride.

2ND Melseed Dont Stop Believing (Mr C Hewitson). Good overall balance. Head well shaped with skull and muzzle of equal length. Ears high set. Strong neck. Not quite the layback of shoulder as the winner. Chest has enough depth. I would like a little more rib. Well made hindquarters with good width of second thigh. Super bone and feet. Coat of oily texture. Moved soundly.

3RD Battsrock So Fine from Sharbae (Mrs S Baxandall)

Limit Bitch (2, 1)

1ST Oakmarsh Laurel JW (Mrs L & Mr L & Miss K Blaber). Well balanced all through. Correct head proportions with good width of skull and equal length of muzzle. I would like a little more angulation in the forequarters. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with correctly turned stifles. Stands square all round. Coat of good oily texture. Moved out well.

Open Bitch (3)

1ST Sh Ch Arnac Bay Harvest (Mr D & Mrs T Thompson). I have always liked this bitch and she still continues to catch my eye. Strongly made but still feminine. She has a well shaped head with small high set ears. Skull and muzzle of equal length. Well laid shoulder with corresponding return of upper arm. Chest of good depth and width. Good spring of rib. Strong, well muscled hindquarters with nicely bent stifles. Excellent bone and feet. Excellent coat texture. Moved well. RCC and RBIS.

2ND Glaneils Don't Worry Be Happy (Mrs C & Mr S & Mrs M & Mr J Broomfield & Broomfield & Mahon-Hunns & Newton). Another quality bitch. Well balanced all through. Well shaped head with slight stop and good breadth of skull. I would like a little more length of neck. Well laid shoulders. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Well made hindquarters with quality bone and excellent feet. Excellent coat texture. Strong movement.

3RD Muireatai Miracle of Dreams (Miss L Murray)

Veteran Bitch (4,1)

1ST Sh Ch Oakmarsh Dancing Diva VW (Miss C A Pont). Another bitch that I have always liked and a very worthy title holder. Well balanced all through. Excellent head shape with skull and muzzle of equal length. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters with correctly bent stifles and good width of second thigh, Well placed hocks. Quality bone and good feet. Coat of excellent texture. Moved out well. BVIS

2ND Arnac Bay Grebe with Riptide (Mr R & Mrs S Playle & Thomas). Good overall balance. Well shaped head with good breadth of skull. Strong neck leading to well laid shoulders and return of upper arm. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Preferred hindquarters of winner. Coat of good oily texture. Excellent bone and feet. Moved soundly.

3RD Arnac Bay Gamble (Mr D & Mrs T Thompson)

Special Working Bitch (3, 2)

1ST Battsrock Sweet Child O Mine Wgc (Mrs D & Mr T Herring). Workmanlike and well balanced all through. Well shaped head with good breadth of skull. Strong neck. Well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Correct depth of chest and length of ribcage. Strong, well muscled hindquarters with well placed hocks. Coat of good oily texture. Moved out on a good stride.

Special Beginners Bitch (2,1)

1ST Oakmarsh Land of Promise of Roguehart (Mrs A & Mrs N Mellersh-Tett). Strongly made workmanlike bitch. Good overall balance. Head has good breadth however I would prefer a little more length of muzzle. Good depth of chest and well sprung ribcage. Strong hindquarters. Good bone and feet. Coat of oily texture. Moved soundly

Wild Fowling Class (5)

1ST Chesepe Viroqua (Mr N Glanville). I absolutely loved this bitch and wish she had been entered in the main part of the show as she would have featured highly. It has long been said that some of the best dogs never see a show ring and this bitch is a perfect example of this. Well balanced all through. She has a super head with correct breadth of skull, slight stop and strong jaw. Clean neck leading to well laid shoulders and return of upper arm. Chest of good depth and ribcage well sprung. Strong hindquarters with well placed hocks. Coat of good density and texture. Accurate driving movement. One can not dwell or predict what might have been but I feel very confident that had she been shown in her younger days she would have gained her title with ease. She actually probably still could. I thank her sporting owner for bringing her today. It was a real treat to judge her.
