CBRC Autumn Working Test Weekend 2026

28-31 August 2026

St Clears, Carmarthenshire

This year the CBRC autumn working test is going to be held over the August bank holiday weekend at a beautiful location on the River Taf between St Clears and Laugharne in Carmarthenshire, South Wales.

We will be having a training day on the Saturday, and our club working test on the Sunday, but we have booked the campsite for the whole bank holiday weekend so if you wish, you can make it a holiday for Chesapeakes.

The location

The Marsh Campsite, Morfa Bach, St Clears, Carmarthenshire SA33 4HD

The Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club has sole use of the campsite and 60 acre training ground from Friday to Monday. The campsite has a farm shop, toilet and showers, and the training ground is 60 acres of varied ground, including a river.

The cost

A fee of £100 will cover camping for three nights (Fri, Sat, Sun nights), and the training day (for one dog) on the Saturday.

Places on the campsite are limited, in particular the pitches with hook-ups. If you have not already reserved your camping pitch, please contact Anthony to check availability.

Training day

If you are camping, the cost of the training day is included. If you would like to train two dogs, you can either swop dogs at lunchtime, or pay an extra £50 per dog.

If you would like to come to the training day, but prefer not to camp, the training day cost will be £50.

The training day start time is 10 am on Saturday 29 August.

WORKING TEST ENTRY SCHEDULE – *please read before entering*

- Closing date for entries: **21 August 2026**. The closing date for entries will be final. Any entries received after the closing date will NOT be accepted.
- Please only enter each dog in one class.
- If your dog is owned in partnership, ALL owners need to be members of the CBRC.
- All dogs need to be registered with the Royal Kennel Club (or have an ATC number).
- WT entries £12.00 per class for each dog.
- You can pay the entry by bank transfer, cheque or PayPal.
 - If you are paying by bank transfer, please include 'AWT2026' in your payment reference.
 - Please make cheques payable to *Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club*.
 - If paying by PayPal, please use the 'friends and family' option (or the CBRC will be charged).

There are four classes at this working test:

PUPPY: For dogs of 6 months but not exceeding 18 months on the day of the test.

NOVICE DOG/NOVICE HANDLER: For dogs of any age. ND/NH comprises similar tests to those in Puppy. It is aimed at those who are completely new to working tests, and would like to have a go. Neither dog nor handler can have gained *any* gundog working test place or field trial award, or have won a Novice Dog/Novice Handler.

BEGINNER: For dogs not having won two or more CBRC Beginner tests, or won any Novice gundog working test, or an award in any CBRC Unclassified Open test, any Open working test, or any Field Trial award.

UNCLASSIFIED OPEN: Open to all.

BEST VETERAN: There is no separate Veteran class. The Best Veteran trophy is awarded to the highest scoring dog aged 8 years old or older, from either the ND/NH, Beginner or Unclassified Open classes.

Dogs who run 'Not for Competition' cannot compete in any classes.

Please only enter one class.

Working test start time

Meet 9.30 am for a 10.00 am start

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- Spectators are welcome at the working test. Please let the organisers know beforehand if you wish to come and watch.
 - *We will need dummy throwers and stewards* – roles that always provide the best views of the dogs – so if you are willing to help out with this, please let us know.
 - There will be a **RAFFLE** so any raffle prizes will be gratefully received.
 - No bitches in season will be allowed on the ground.
 - Please keep dogs on a lead at all times, except under the trainer's instruction or in the designated exercise area. Please respect the landowner. Keep all gates closed and clean up after your dogs.

All is set for a great weekend, training and testing our dogs together, so we hope you can join us
